PROFILE

Ebbe Volquardsen is an Associate Professor of Cultural History in the Department of Social and Cultural History at Ilisimatusarfik, the University of Greenland.

With an academic background in cultural anthropology, Scandinavian studies, and political science, he adopts an interdisciplinary approach in his work. For over a decade, he has focused on the cultural history of Greenland and the enduring colonial legacies that shape its relationship with Denmark and other global actors. His research includes analyses of historiography, internal and external representations in literature, film, and visual arts, public discourse, and the political implications of these narratives today.

Volquardsen's research interests include representations of Nordic colonialism in the North Atlantic and the Global South, explored as part of broader patterns of exceptionalist thinking. He also works on memory politics, nationalism, and processes of political and mental decolonization and reconciliation—examining the aftereffects of imperialism in both former colonies and former metropoles. His research and teaching are informed by memory studies, cultural studies, postcolonial theory, affect theory, gender theory, and insights from social psychology.

He teaches and supervises in the fields of anthropology, cultural history, literature, and cultural studies, advocating a "history-from-below" approach that seeks to counteract historiographical bias.

Originally from the German side of the Danish-German border region, Volquardsen publishes and lectures in Danish, English, and German. He has previously taught at Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin, the University of Cologne, and the University of Greifswald.
