Research profile

I am researching the conditions of Greenland's welfare society and focusing on social policy, poverty, disability, voluntarism, the profession, and homelessness. Years of research have led to published work on the sociological history of Greenland, the welfare system, social work, poverty, and social policy under Arctic conditions. On a community and governmental level, I am researching social policy and developing methodologies to tackle homelessness and increase inclusion. The work has led to large professional networks and seats on various professional councils. I am also the head of Ilisimatusarfik's Centre for Arctic Welfare; in addition, I teach and supervise BA, MA, and PhD students.
